End of an era



The tree has 166 growth rings, making it 166 years old. It was therefore planted around 1851. At over 25 meters in height, it dominated its location in Woodfold View, Corscombe. Sadly it was leaning towards houses nearby at an ever increasing angle, which meant it was becoming more unstable over time.

This giant redwood tree, called a Wellintonia, is native to California, and was planted as part of a series of trees along Common Lane; probably regarded as a status symbol in the 1850's

Jim Hawkins, of Applewood Tree Surgeons, undertook the work in a most professional and safe manner. The wood has been bought by a timber merchant, and will probably be used to make garden furniture (for which it is well suited).
