Nordcat Weekly Bus Service

I have been using the Nordcat Bus Service most Fridays and a few Wednesdays over the past few years.

Unfortunately, in recent weeks I have been unable to take the bus, and I have heard that numbers are dwindling. In order to keep this service going we need as many people as possible to support this! Just think if you ever have problems with eye-sight, you could have to give up driving, so even if you now drive, think about using this service.

Think about not having to find a car parking space. Also think about the jolly group of people you will meet from Corscombe and other Villages. Think about the adage *'Use it or lose it'*.

The Bus can call at or near people's homes on a Wednesday for trips to Dorchester and on a Friday to Yeovil (both on market days). Times may vary a little due to traffic or road works.

Book a place on the bus at least 24 hours before you travel (01258 473154), but first contact Nordcat to have your name on their list. You will need to pay a small fee to belong. When you ring ask for a bus timetable and a leaflet on the additional days out that they offer.

The approximate time they pick up in Corscombe is between 11am and 11.30am. The Office Staff will normally ring you if there are hold ups.

The return journeys depart between 2.30pm and 3pm

Litter

I know there was a litter picking event in March, yet at the end of March, rubber glove and dustbin bag in hand, I walked from Yew Tree Farm to the reservoir area on Hackney and picked up a full bag of litter; consisting of plastic bags and bottles, food cartons, sweet papers, even dog poo bags (full), and other rubbish.
