Responder groups were set up to support the ambulance service in its target of being on scene within 8-minutes for patients with a life threatening condition. Because the ambulance service now receives many more calls than it used to, it is under pressure from lower level calls for help - calls that do not relate to life threatening conditions.

As a consequence, Responders are being asked to attend patients with less serious issues.

There is a new piece of equipment that will be of immediate benefit to patients who have fallen and cannot get themselves up from the floor. You can see it in operation by visiting the following link, or by putting **Raizer Chair** into a Google search:
