We are thinking about putting on a first aid course that would be

free to participants. The idea is to give local people the skill to cope in a medical emergency. Our aim as Responders is to

- Provide direct support to residents in a medical emergency (we work through the 999 system)
- Provide medical equipment for resident use (the defibrillators in Halstock and Corscombe, and also First Aid kits in the two village halls)
- Train as many local residents as possible in essential first aid skills (so help to a family member or neighbours would be immediately available in an emergency)
- Provide annual training in CPR and use of the community defibrillators

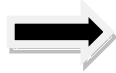

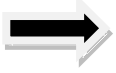
